The Alpentänzer Schuhplattler

We're reaching out on behalf of the Alpentänzer Schuhplattler, a local nonprofit group that preserves and celebrates Bavarian and Austrian traditions through authentic music and dancing at community and cultural events throughout Northern California.

Our approximately 30 active members are all volunteers who rehearse and perform for the pure enjoyment of the experience. Nominal fees paid by host



organizations are used to help fund our sound equipment, travel, and authentic costumes made for us in Bavaria.





The Alpentänzer Schuhplattler is a section of the Sacramento Turn Verein, a German cultural center founded in 1854 and headquartered since 1925 at the Turner Hall on J Street in East Sacramento, home of the region's largest and most authentic German festivals.

Our group is also a member of the Gauverband Nordamerika, an affiliation of 72 similar clubs created over the past 200 years throughout the US and Canada to honor and share Bavarian and Austrian culture through traditional music, dancing, costumes, and gatherings.

In early April 2024, the Alpentänzer Schuhplattler will observe its 50th anniversary with a weekend

celebration that will share these traditions with our fellow US and Canadian clubs, as well as members of the Sacramento Turn Verein, sponsors, and our special guests.





A Cultural Tradition

The highlight of our 50th anniversary celebration will be the consecration of the Alpentänzer Schuhplattler's new Fahne, or ceremonial flag, currently being produced in a specialized workshop in Bavaria.



The tradition of such flags, or Fahnen, dates to medieval times in Europe, from which time they have served to identify and foster unity within geographic and social groups. There are Fahnen for cities, villages, churches, social clubs, and more.

In modern Bavaria, every significant institution proudly maintains its own Fahne, some of which are hundreds of years old. The Fahne is raised and flourished during key celebrations

such as annual festivals and member weddings or funerals. It is carefully displayed in club facilities throughout the year.

In keeping with this tradition, most of the clubs in the Gauverband Nordamerika have such a Fahne that is displayed and preserved according to timehonored custom.

Each Fahne is custom designed for the institution it represents, with one side depicting the purpose and activities of the group, while the other side reflects its location. Text elements reinforce these themes, including the group's founding year and motto.

Production of Fahnen, though aided today by some digital tools, remains an artisanal process



executed by highly skilled craftspeople with decades of experience using the finest silks, velvets, and threads to look and last as they should. There are only a handful of workshops in Bavaria that produce Fahnen.







Growing decade by decade from a tiny dancer group, the Alpentänzer Schuhplattler is today one of the largest and most vibrant in the western region of the Gauverband Nordamerika. And we are one of only a few that performs with a full Bavarian band – including two alphorns – to entertain our audiences.

After many years of building a fund with saving from our

performance fees, the Alpentänzer Schuhplattler decided that our 50th anniversary was the perfect time to upgrade from our simple printed banner to a more formal and traditional Fahne that reflects our long history and vibrant activity.



Members of our group spent countless hours researching imagery, layout, colors, and mottoes to create a distinctive design befitting this cultural tradition and representing our unique location and structure.

As is customary for such major capital projects, our members

are now tasked with reaching out


